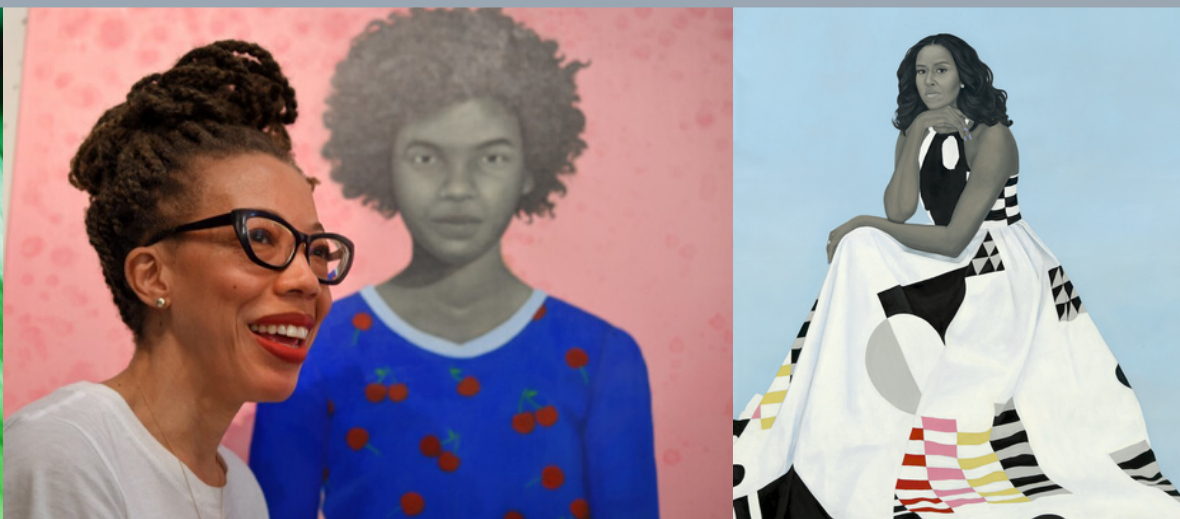

Supplies: tissue paper, feathers, embellishments, glue



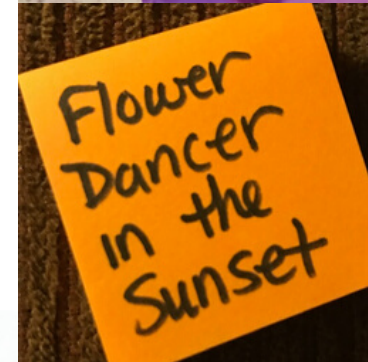
Step 1: Choose your decorations.
